1. The admitted patient has to deposit the advance as follows :

- General Ward : 5000/-
- ICU : 20000/-
- Pvt. Room : 10000/-
- NICU : 5000/-

The amount should always be available in your account. Please find out the expenses of the previous day every morning from the reception and deposit the amount as per the requirement.

- The entire money of the operation / package has to be deposited before the operation.
- Attendant card - Only one attendant card will be given for each patient. It is necessary to hang your pass around your neck to go to ward / ICU. A person with no pass will not be allowed to enter the ward.
- Children under 12 years of age are not allowed to enter the ward.
- No person will be allowed to stay in or enter hospital area from 8pm to 6am. For the convenience of attendants, dharmashala and guest house are available near the hospital.
- No attendant is allowed to stay with the patient admitted in ICU. One attendant can meet for only 5 minutes between 8:30 to 9:30 in the morning and 5:00 to 6:00 in the evening. The condition of the patient will be explained by the doctor at the same time. In case of any special improvement or decline in the condition, update will be given to attendant.
- All admitted patients must wear hospital clothes. Out side clothing, bed sheets, shoes-slippers will not be allowed in the ward. Cloak Room facilities are available near the main gate guard room.
- It may take 2 to 3 hours to prepare the bill on discharge. If someone is in a hurry he can deposit lumpsum amount in advance. After the bill is ready you can take due amount.
- Protect your valuables, luggage, mobile & money etc.
- General ward's patient can be shifted from one room to another room at any time as per hospital requirement.
- The patient of Insurance / Corporate should inform at the billing counter before being admitted. Hospital may refuse to provide cashless facility later.

ICU

- The patient's attendant are not allowed to go to ICU. Attendant can meet the patient only at the scheduled time.
- Very sick patient are kept in ICU. The patient's condition may improve but patient condition can suddenly worsen and sudden death can also occur. The patient may have to be referred to Jaipur-Delhi or Agra suddenly and even during night. I understand all these things and I want my patient to be treated in this hospital.

Interpretation:

PRELIMINARY INTERPRETATION:

Measurement of CRP is useful for the detection and evaluation of infection, tissue injury, inflammatory disorders and associated diseases.

High sensitivity CRP (hsCRP) measurements may be used as an independent risk marker for the identification of individuals at risk for future cardiovascular disease.

Increase in CRP values are non-specific and should not be interpreted without a complete history.
